From the bottom line of the checking and savings accounts we appear to have fallen short on the Income vs Expenses. We received \$2,989.03 and spent \$3,305.09. As was stated the last time we raised the dues from \$25 to \$30, that probably might cover the expenses. You will notice that we missed the budget by \$316.06 and we still have a few back months of telephone charges that have to be reimbursed and a Christmas party to pay for and maybe a few misc other charges.

What hurt the bottom line, was the expendature for the VoCom amplifier and Xtal filter.

If we want to stay up with technology, put a little back in the savings, and spend some money for the remote receivers, antennas, power supplies and the misc other little goodies, I suggest that we concider a \$5 increase this year, or making donations in addition to your renewal. \$5 for 100 members = \$500, 200 members = \$1,000.

It is that time again to re-instate your status as an active supporter of the North Fulton Amateur Radio League. You will find enclosed in this newsletter a renewal form. Please show your support.

You will also find a report by category so you can see where we spent our money for the last 11 months.

Please plan to attend the November meeting for elections and socializing with your fellow hams. Your vote and support does count.

The Netherlands, September 13, 1992

Hello, Everybody,

Everything here is going great. School has started and I'm getting computer class for the first time ever. It's pretty easy. English literature however is very Hard! It is taught by a British lady who has read every piece of literature on the planet and loves homework.

As far as amateur radio is concerned, I went on a foxhunt -- my first ever. The area where the transmitter might be located was over 25 km! I went with two guys from the local amateur radio The beacon was on 144.9900 MHz and played computer generated music! This is perfectly legal during foxhunts! It started at 8:00 PM and we found the transmitter at 1:30 AM! It was great. We were stuck on a huge farm field at 12:45 with only moonlight and back-lid LCD displays on H-Ts as light sources. Using a small 2-element beam and a HT we were the second out of five to find the "fox". The "fox" had a horizontal 15 element beam tilted 45 degrees to confuse people. When we got close it was hard because the signal was so strong. And don't think that since the Netherlands is so flat that DFing is easy. Trees, buildings, and even cars reflect signals causing false readings. There are also few high spots to get above ground clutter. But, it was a lot of I hope everyone is okay and I hope the repeaters are doing fine and that N4QXH got his voicemail on 147060+. My address is on the back. Please send all mail airmail or it will take 2-3-4 months before I get it. It takes 1-2 WEEKS with airmail. Packet is much faster (1-2 DAYS!) but I'm not authorized yet to use that. I will get my packet address ASAP to y'all.

Hi, guys, I hope all is OK. Everything here is going well, but I hat not being able to pick up my HT, dial in 145470- or 147060-, and drop in KC4ZLU and start talking to y'all. I miss the NFARL and Hamwatch a lot. But I may be able to 'make contact' with you all after all. As David Fellows KD4APK probably already knows, the phone booths here, like in the US use a DTMF dialing system. I noticed this while making a local call from my neighborhood train station. Anyway, an idea hit. I went inside the train station and changed the equivalent of \$5 US into quarters and went back to the phone booth and dialed international access US area code 404 and the phone # to 145470. I heard the familiar beep=beep. I entered in some numbers and the response came -- User 209 ... patch to air. I heard what I thought was APK talking with (I think) KC4YBT. dropped my call in and surprised APK with my QTH. However, the QSO was short because I watched the little LCD display on the phone count away all my money. I was just able to sign off before it hung up on me. I am going to attempt this again when I find a cheaper way to call the US. I think that I have. AT&T has a commercial on CNN (yes, we get CNN and MTV here) to call the US via AT&T and it is 75% cheaper. Hmmmm. A second attempt might be made! What a way to get DXCC on 2 meter FM repeater. 145470- was booming in that phone booth at 59+60 db Full quieting! What other repeater has made it into Europe (at all) with such a signal!?!?! 98 TO GO!

Looks like the 100 watt amp is doing its job well! Anyway, as far as amateur radio is concerned here, it is very boring because of all the restrictive rules. I have rarely touched my 2m HT at all while I have been here. Oh yes, I will most likely be back sometime next summer so N4QXH, sign me up for some Public Service events! KD4IKZ -- hope that packet is fun! Anyway, I gotta run now, I've got homework to do! Good luck to all of you and stay in good health.
