The receiver is also back to where it ought to be. We still had some deafness to the receiver, but I think all that has been cured now. I have to say, the lightning strike we took on the 145.47 machine was probably the worst I have seen, and it really took a lot of traveling up and down the mountain and 100-105 degree days to get this fixed, and a lot of help from others, (KS4KJ, W4QO, WB4MAK, WA4YNZ, and KJ4HE, and maybe some others I forgot, and if I did I am sorry) to put Humpty Dumpty back together again, but alas, I think it is done. And again I want to say thank you for your patience. Our next step is to now get the 147.06 repeater back on the air and I will be attacking that before our next meeting. I'm not sure that everyone is aware of the situation on the 444.475 repeater, so I will try to explain. Several years ago, we had a GE repeater running up on Sweat Mtn., and basically it broke. So KD4GT was kind enough to loan us his Motorola MSF 5000 repeater. Then he and his new bride took residence up in Tennessee along I-40 and decided to move his repeater up to TN. The moving of that repeater took place just before I went to Africa this last summer and has not been replaced. As another project of mine, I am building another GE MasterII repeater for that frequency. It won't happen this week or next, but it is eminent. Thank you for your patience. I would also like to get someone involved that has skills in 2.4Ghz Wifi to help put up a link to Sweat Mtn. If you are interested, please contact me.
