Repeater Status – Since the last months report on the repeaters we started generating some complaints about the power level of the repeater and yes it was down. We had a visit from mother nature. Currently we are attempting to get the amplifier fixed but have been having some problems making power from the amplifier boards I have. In case you are wondering, the power level the repeater is currently radiating is 200 milliwatts. Yes that's correct 2/10ths of a watt. Coverage is not really all that bad considering we are actually running QRP. Well tonight, 8/16/2007 I am putting a 5 watt amp up there just to help fill in some of the holes. If all works according to hoyle, which it hasn't been for several weeks now, within a week we should be back up to power again. See you at the meeting on tuesday.
