Repeater News! - The replacement for the 147.06 repeater is complete and it has been installed. It features the same new controller as was installed on the 444.475 machine. It is located on the water tower in downtown Roswell where it shares space with the co-op machine from MATPARC on 443.150. We currently have the radio in hand that will be used as the replacement for the 145.47 repeater. Crystals are on order, and the controller card is also on order. Once the crystals and controller are received, the work will begin on completing the 145.47 radio conversion. I just want to say thanks for all the help I have received over the last year in rebuilding these club repeaters, as well as standing by the club. There are still bigger plans in the works for all the NFARL repeaters.
