Repeater News - The club's newest repeater (a joint venture with the MATPARC club) is the 224.62 repeater. Set your rig for MINUS 1.6 MHZ and PL100. If you do not have PLL, dial **7411**.

Some of you may have noticed that there is currently an underlying mix of very low level music that has recently been introduced to the 145.47 repeater. We are currently working on resolving the removal of that from the repeater. The physical environment that our repeaters as well as most other repeaters live in, is typically a very nasty RF environment. As an example, 145.47, 224.62 and 444.475 all co-habitate with 2 FM broadcast stations and 5 TV stations all within a 100 foot radius, and all of these stations transmit in excess of 20,000 watts ERP. So please bear with us as we try to correct this problem, and we do appreciate your patience.
